

TOWN OF ROSTHERN

BYLAW 2013-11

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ROSTHERN TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 2008-07, KNOWN AS THE OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN OF THE TOWN OF ROSTHERN.

The Council of the Town of Rosthern, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2008-07 as follows:

- 1) In Section 1.3, after last sentence, add new sentence:

“This Official Community Plan will be used in conjunction with the Twin Rivers District Plan”.
- 2) In Section 2.1 after “Rural Municipality of Rosthern”, add:

“and the Twin Rivers Planning District”.
- 3) In Section 3.9.3 (1) after “with the R.M. of Rosthern . . .” insert “and the Twin Rivers Planning District”.
- 4) In Section 4.2.1 add the following subsection:

(5) Council may refer subdivision applications to the Twin Rivers District Planning Commission for review and comments. Discretionary use applications may, at Council’s discretion, be submitted to the District Planning Commission for review and comment.
- 5) In Section 4.3 add the following subsection:

4.3.8 The Twin Rivers District Plan is intended to guide future land uses with the participating municipalities, which include the Rural Municipalities of Duck Lake No. 463, Rosthern No. 403, and Laird No. 404; the Towns of Hague, Hepburn, Rosthern, Waldheim and Duck Lake; and the Village of Laird.
- 6) This bylaw shall become effective on the date of approval by the Minister of Government Relations.

Introduced and read a FIRST time this 30th day of July, 2013.
Read a SECOND time this 2nd day of December, 2013.
Read a THIRD time and passed this 2nd day of December, 2013.
