There are various frauds/scams that affect Canadians every day. They come in the form of phone, mail and online scams. The majority of people that fall victim to these scams are between the ages of 50 to 59. Here are some tips to help protect yourself.

1. Be cautious about providing confidential personal information, banking or credit card details, unless you are certain the company is legitimate.
2. Don't be afraid to ask questions and see if you get legitimate answers.
3. If you are unsure or in doubt about a potential scam, talk to someone you can trust about it.
4. If you suspect it is a scam, hang up the phone, throw out the mail, delete the email and report the incident to the Canadian Anti Fraud Centre 1-888-495-8501

Remember: if it sounds too good to be true or you have to pay first to get a large sum of money - it's a scam!
