Bylaw 2010-06

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS IN
THE TOWN OF ROSTHERN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN.**

The Council of the Town of Rosthern, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) This bylaw may be referred to as the “General Penalty Bylaw” of the municipality.
- 2) Sections 3 and 4 apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
- 3) Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Municipalities Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 and costs for every offence.
- 4) Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of *The Municipalities Act*, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 and costs for every offence.
- 5) Bylaw 2001-19 is hereby repealed.
