Hospital Indications

Frequently questions are asked about our anticipated new hospital project: Is the project going to proceed? When? Where? and so on.

We wait for the provincial government to give the official go-ahead for this important town and regional project. Meanwhile, Rosthern along with our Twin Rivers partners, continues to do our part in anticipation of this project becoming a reality.

1. Land has been purchased to the southwest of town to locate the new hospital. Health officials and our MLA have been apprised and have endorsed this location.
2. Water and sewer infrastructure has recently been installed off 4th Ave, heading west to accommodate new construction.
3. Fundraising efforts continue and significant contributors have been identified going forward once the project is announced. Income from fundraising will offset the amount and time required for ratepayers to come up with their 20% of project costs.
4. Construction of a new house in Rosthern nears completion. All revenues raised from this project will be directed to the hospital project.
5. The physicians' group is working hard on its plans to build a new expanded clinic to serve Twin Rivers clients. Plans are for this project to be sited in close proximity to where the hospital will be located.
6. Regular conversations occur with our MLA, ministers and health district officials to keep this project moving forward.

Large projects such as this require an exceptional effort, time and yes, patience.
