Rosthern Water: Beautiful!

A friend commented how good it was to be back home in Rosthern after a prolonged stay in a Saskatoon hospital. One item he was particularly grateful for and which he sorely missed when away was "wonderful refreshing Rosthern water...I just turned on my kitchen tap; the water was waiting for me... beautiful".

I totally love this sentiment, even more so after water service on my street was disrupted a few weeks ago. Corrosion had taken its toll again, and another water break ensued. Seeing the repair process take place from my front window gave me renewed respect and appreciation for our Town employees. After hard work, with major risk factors in play and taking most of a Saturday and a Sunday, our water was back on by Sunday evening with appropriate water quality testing procedures in place.

Fifty- to sixty-year-old cast-iron water mains have run their course. Water break incidents will only increase in the next few years. To face this significant challenge, council and administration are embarking on an expedited repair schedule to replace the remaining cast-iron water mains. To help cover costs, yours, mine, everyone's water charges will be increased incrementally over the next several years. The decision to raise water prices is not made lightly. The cost of delaying necessary repairs even longer would be vastly more expensive and disruptive. We appreciate your understanding and support on this initiative. For more information please get in touch with myself, a councillor or the Town Office.

Meanwhile, take a moment and say thanks to our Public Works Manager Owen and his team for all they do to keep healthy and wonderful water flowing to your home. Enjoy a wonderful glass of Rosthern water! Cheers!
